# **Union County Facts**

2016 Student Wellness Survey (SWS) data indicates that 60.6% of Union County 11th graders have never tried marijuana.

8th grade past 30 day use of alcohol was 23% in 2014, but has decreased to 12.6% in 2016 according to the SWS.

Congratulations Union County for the **Big**Changes since 2010 in youth substance
use. Past 30 day use rates have declined
for substances tracked by the student
wellness survey, including: alcohol,
tobacco, marijuana and prescription drugs.
